1. Rare Chinese Blue and White Porcelain Rouleau Vase
(ILLUSTRATED ON COVER)
KANGXI PERIOD, CA: LATE 17TH CENTURY
Decorated with reserves of the famed Eight Scholars of the Wine Cup.
Height: 21 inches (53.5 cm.)
2. Chinese Camellia Leaf Green Porcelain Vase
QIANLONG/ JIAQING PERIOD,
MID-18TH-EARLY 19TH CENTURY
Height: 12 ½ inches (31.8 cm.)
With carved wood base
Ex Collection: J.P. Morgan
Exhibited at the Metropolitan Museum of Art through the early 20th century.

3. Superb Pair of Chinese Porcelain figures of Europeans

KANGXI PERIOD, CA: 1700-1715

Likely depicting the Dauphin, son of Louis XIV.

Height with bases: 9 ½ inches (24.2 cm.)

Ex Collection: Nelson Rockefeller

Ex Collection: Esprito Santo, Lisbon

squirrels.

KANGXI PERIOD, CA: LATE 17TH CENTURY
Decorated with a scene from the famous *Romance of the Western Chamber*.
Diameter: 15 ¼ inches (38.7 cm.)

10. Rare Pair of Chinese Noire-Rose Porcelain Teapots
QIANLONG PERIOD, CA: MID-18TH CENTURY
Of fine form and very rare color.
Height: 5 ½ inches (14 cm.)
Ex: Partridges's, early-mid 1900's.

4. Chinese Famille Noire Teapot and Cover
KANGXI PERIOD, AD 1662-1722
With openwork decoration of the “Three Friends of Winter.”
Height: 6 ¼ inches (16 cm.)
Similar examples in notable private and museum collections.
5. Unusual Chinese Root Carving
CA: 18TH/ 19TH CENTURY
Suggesting a walking phoenix.
Height with base: 9 ¾ inches (24.7 cm.)
6. Carved Soapstone Figure of a Resting Lohan
17TH/ 18TH CENTURY
Likely representing Pindola Bharadvaja with a tiger at his side.
Height: 2 ¾ inches (7 cm.)
